She argues that in pursuing new audiences more recent soaps such as Brookside may have put at risk the pleasures they have traditionally offered their women viewers. *Women and Soap Opera* is a detailed, thoughtful and wide-ranging analysis which will become a central work in women's studies and media and cultural studies courses.
