The memoir showcases Twain's razor-sharp wit (as well as a healthy imagination), which would later become his trademark style in *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*, *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer*, and *A Connecticut Yankee in King Arthur's Court*. From stagecoach travel to the etiquette of gold hunting, *Roughing It* makes a classic addition to your Mark Twain library and is a perfect example of how funny the world can be when you're traveling with the right person.
