use of these coordinate systems. I have also found that students appreciate (and need) quite a bit of algebra review in their calculus classes. Although many instructors refuse to "backtrack" to cover algebra in a calculus course, I have found that students get the satisfaction of realizing their algebra skills actually have a place in higher levels of math. So, I take time (and space) to do this in many of my examples.
